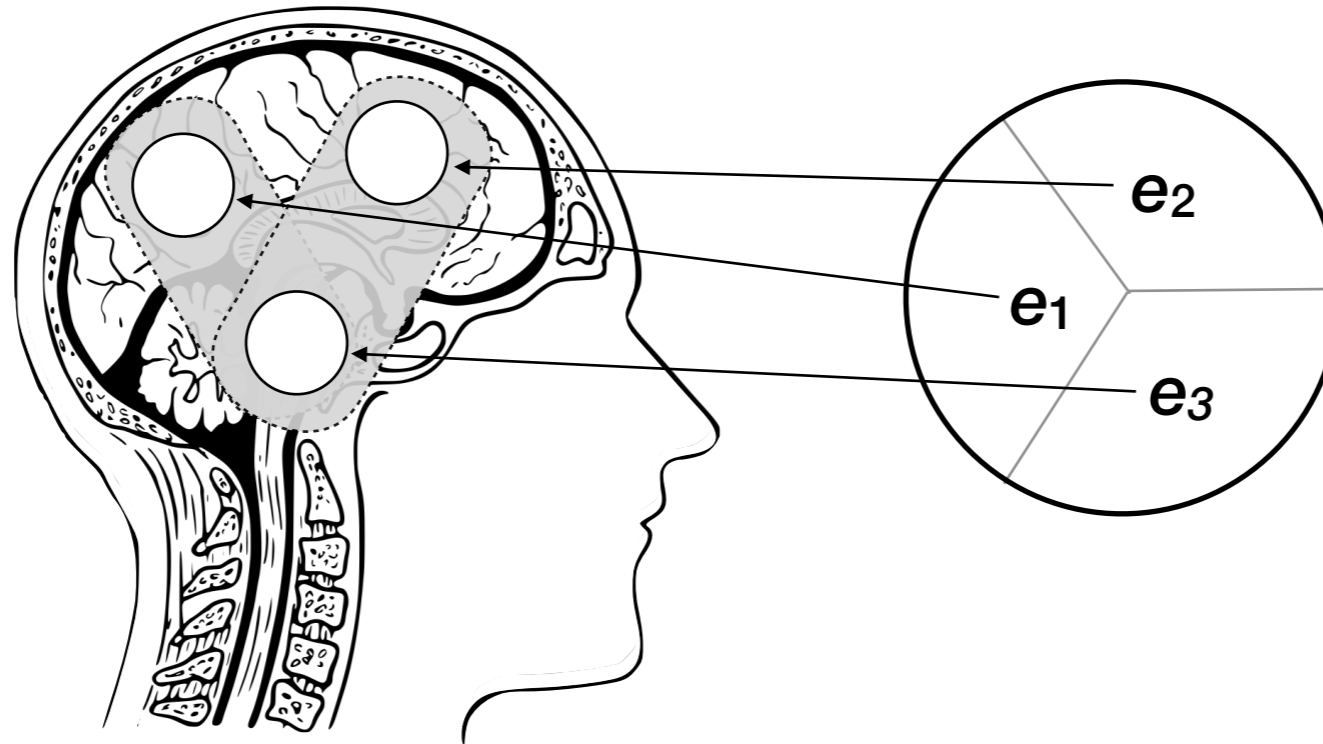
The Scattered Parts View

De Re Modal Knowledge

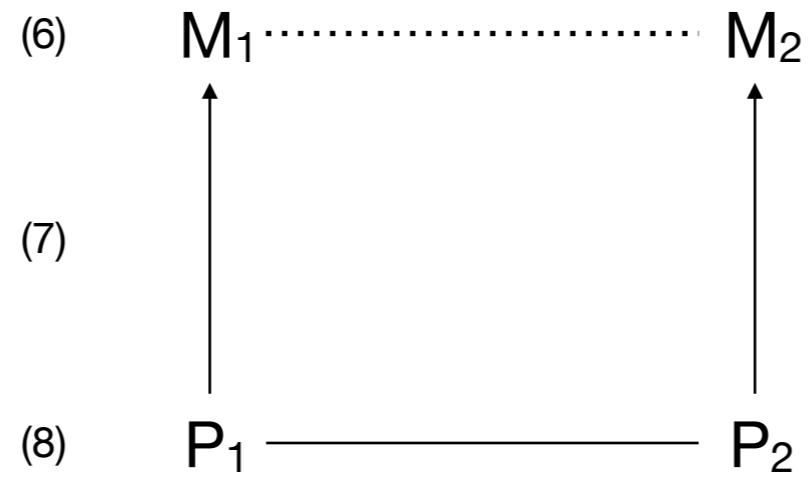

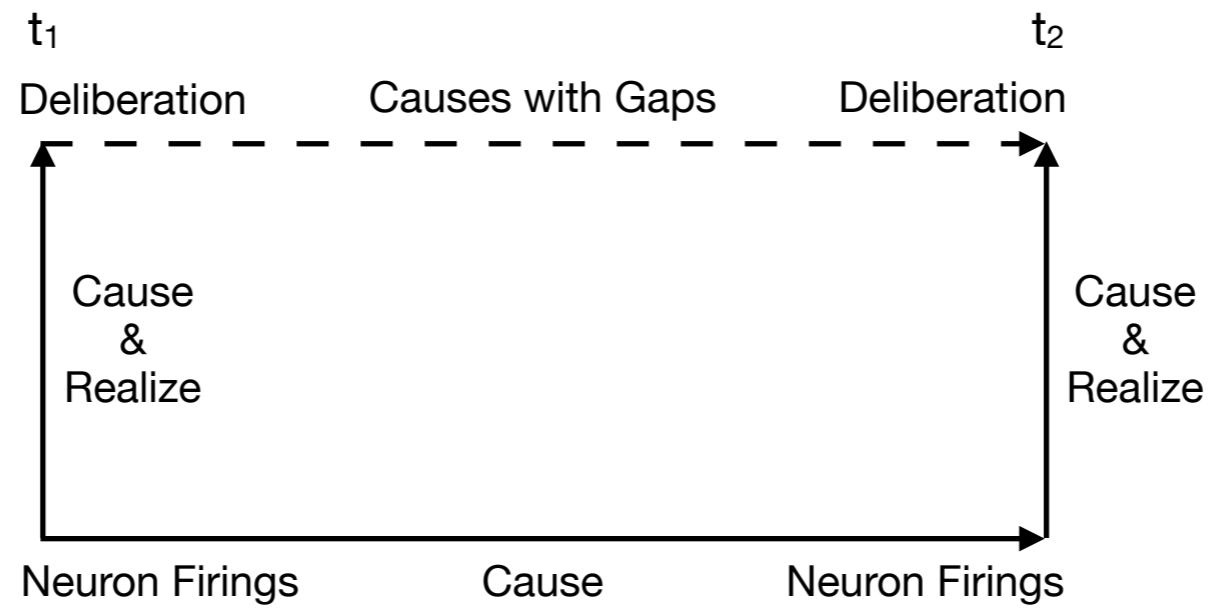

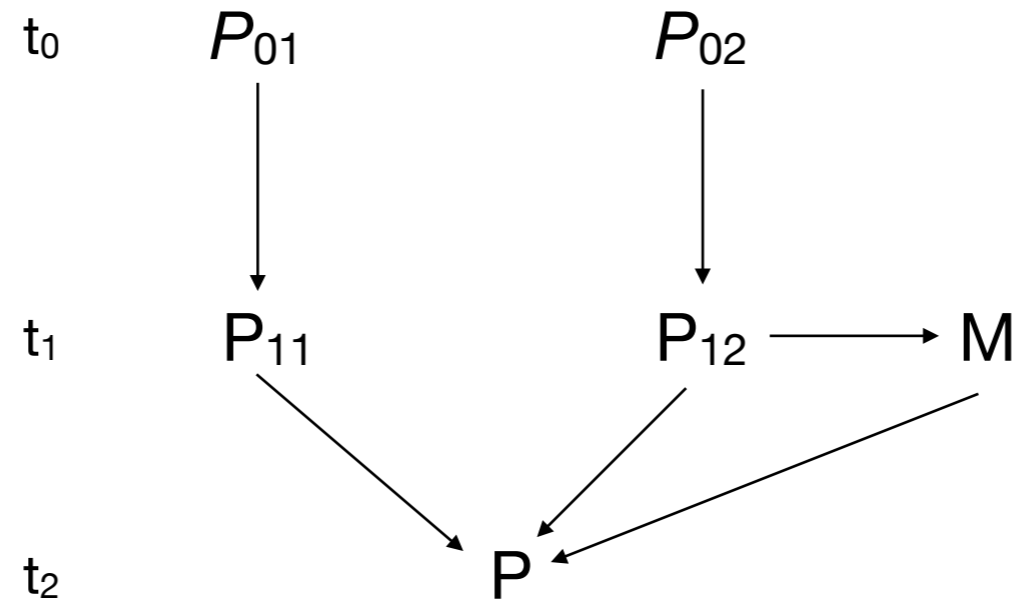
